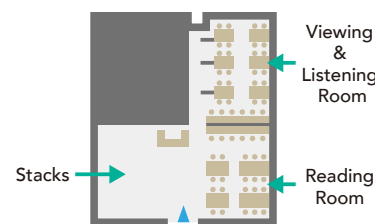

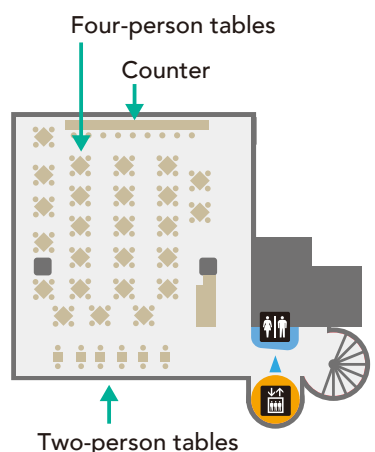

The only entrance to Café Hibiki is a staircase. Please enter from the street on the side of the National Museum of Western Art.



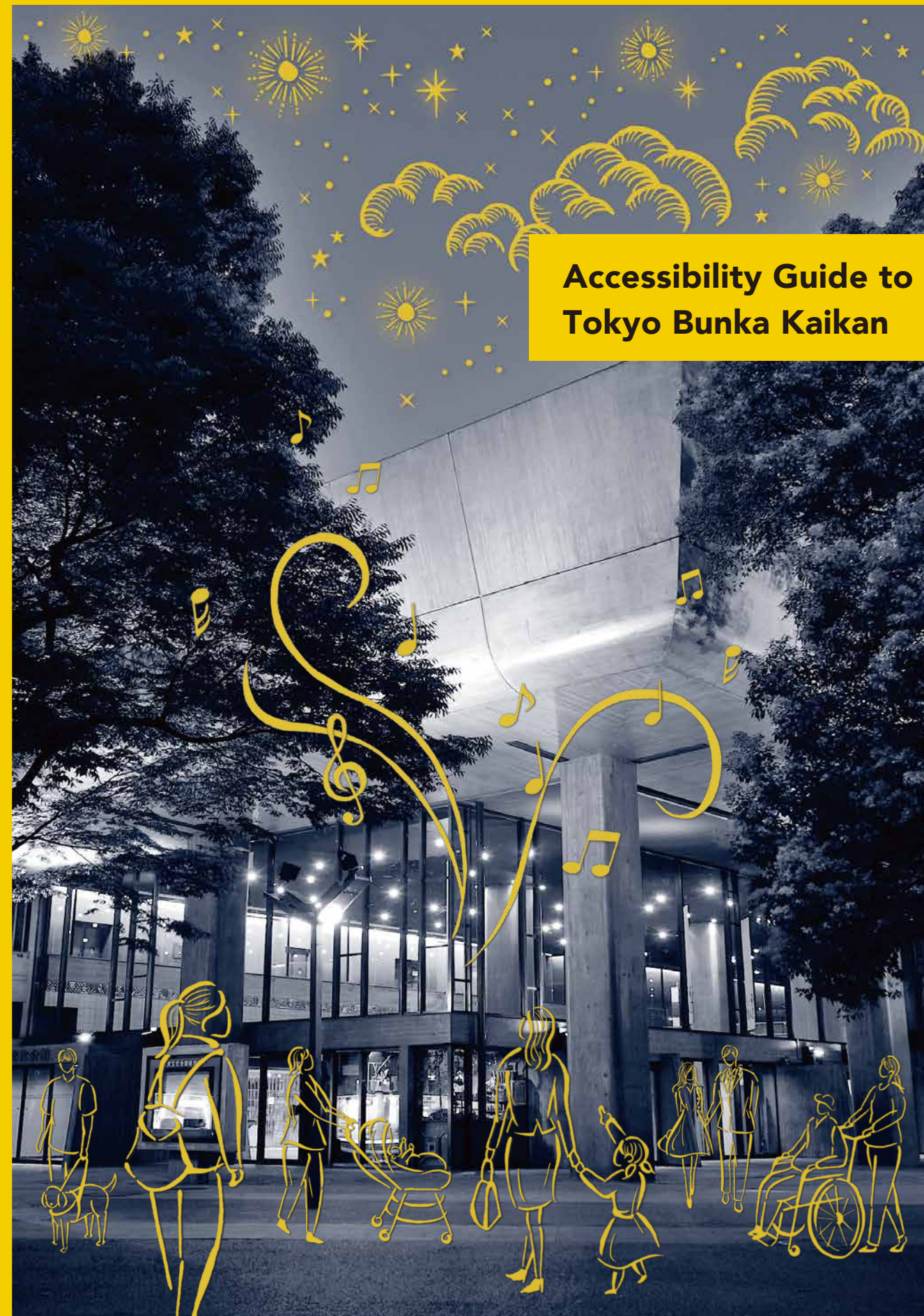

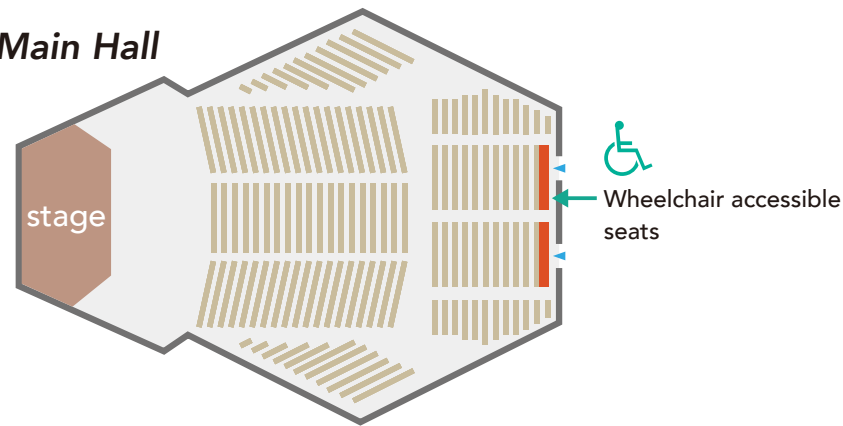
Accessibility Guide to Tokyo Bunka Kaikan



Accessible Information

This leaflet contains information for those who have difficulties using the facilities, such as persons with disabilities, older people, and stroller users. All the staff members will be pleased to offer support so that everyone can enjoy the music.

① Main Hall

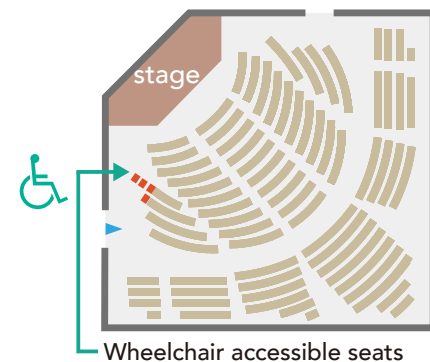


There are 14 wheelchair accessible seats on the rear side of the first floor. The handrails are 77 cm high, allowing people to enjoy music in a comfortable environment without blocking their line of sight. Please contact the organizer of each performance to purchase the tickets for wheelchair accessible seats.

Number of seats: 14

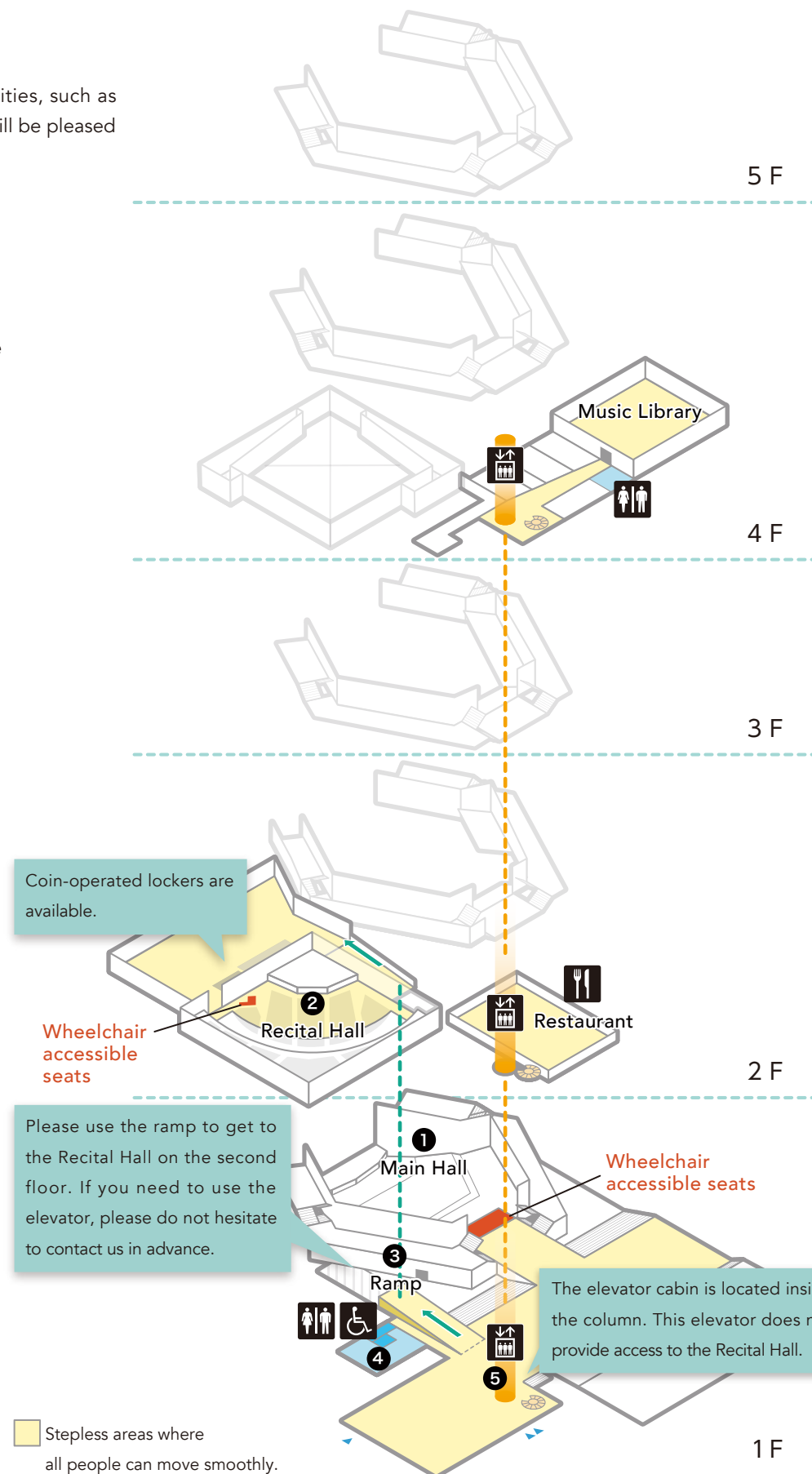
② Recital Hall



There are four wheelchair accessible seats on the left side facing the stage. The aisle to the seats is more than 90 cm wide, allowing wheelchair users to move smoothly to their seats.

③ Ramp

Please use the ramp to get to the Recital Hall on the second floor. If you need to use the elevator, please contact us in advance.

5 Elevator Hall
